Prof. Jing MEN was the Baillet Latour Chair of European Union-China Relations and the Director of EU-China Research Centre in the Department of EU International Relations and Diplomacy Studies at the College of Europe. She has worked for the School of Foreign Languages of Dalian University of Technology since December 2020. She obtained a PhD in Political Science at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel.

Her research and teaching focus on EU-China relations and Chinese foreign policy.
